ARGENTINA VISA

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY, U.S. NATIONALS ARE TEMPORARILY EXEMPT FROM PAYING THE ARGENTINA RECIPROCITY FEE. TRAVELERS HOLDING A U.S. PASSPORT CAN TRAVEL FOR BUSINESS OR TOURISM FOR STAYS UP TO 90 DAYS.

PLEASE NOTE THAT THIS TEMPORARY EXEMPTION MAY BE LIFTED IN THE NEAR FUTURE AND U.S. NATIONALS MAY ONCE AGAIN HAVE TO PAY THE FEE PRIOR TO ENTRY INTO ARGENTINA.

WE WILL UPDATE THE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS AS MORE INFORMATION IS MADE AVAILABLE.
