

Dear Madam / Sir,

Since February 2016, citizens of **Camboya, India, Myanmar, People's Republic of China, Thailand and Vietnam** may travel to Colombia for **tourist/or business stay of 90 days or less** without a visa provided one of the following conditions:

- Being holder of a residence permission in a member state of the Schengen Area - **or** - in the United States of America
- Being holder of a valid Schengen visa or US visa, with a validity of no less than one hundred and eighty (180) days at the moment of the entrance to Colombia. The airport transit visas are not admissible.

You must have a - passport in good condition, with a validity of no less than one hundred and eighty (180) days and with a minimum of two (2) blank pages, return ticket, tourism plan and demonstrate sufficient resources to cover the costs as a tourist in our country. (If required by the Migration Authority)

United States passport holders do not require a Colombian Visa for tourist/business stay of 90 days or less.
