- ❖ ATTENDEES AND/OR UNPAID SPEAKERS (DAILY ALLOWANCES ARE PERMITTED) IN CONFERENCES AND SEMINARS. YOU WILL NEED TO SUBMIT THE ORIGINAL INVITATION LETTER (NOTARIZED BY A BRAZILIAN NOTARY- "CARTORIO") FROM THE SPONSORING ORGANIZATION IN BRAZIL. IF YOU CANNOT PROVIDE THE ORIGINAL NOTARIZED LETTER OR WILL BE PARTICIPATING IN A TRADE SHOW, YOU SHOULD APPLY FOR A VITEM II BUSINESS VISA. IF THE APPLICANT WILL BE RECEIVING HONORARIUM FOR GIVING THE LECTURE THEN THEY SHOULD APPLY FOR A VITEM I VISA
